QComm is excited to release the first look at the \$150 million question! Before you peak at the numbers below....what was your guess?

Although this is not an official FCC notice, all data was mined from the public information on the FCC LMS portal on 2/7/2020.

Stay tuned to <u>repack.tv</u> as we continue to crunch the numbers as the FCC works diligently through the remaining submittals.

- The *Eligible* and *Not Determined* buckets add up to \$145M, which would allow for 100% allocation
- If you are in the 11% Ineligible crowd, but still contesting, there is still some room for stations to be added and maintain 100% allocation.

Q-tip #1 – Heed Winston Churchill's advice (paraphrased): Never, never, never give up! If you are part of the *Ineligible* or *Not Determined* crowd, QComm highly advises that you contact your attorney, consulting engineer or licensing contact to find out why. Your eligibility window may be closing or closed. You can also call the QComm Repack Hotline, 816-882-5600. We may be of assistance. Thus far, 95% of QComm Repack clients have been determined *Eligible*.

Next steps:

As the FCC wraps up the last remaining Eligibility determinations, the next phase is the review of the funds requested. Now is a good time to go over your 399 with your engineer, attorney, or project manager to review your configuration for reasonableness.
